

# COVID-19 Risk Assessment - Management of dressing rooms

Both home team and away side players will be advised to arrive dressed in their football strip ready to play. This should negate the need to use dressing room facilities prior to kick-off. However, it is likely that changing facilities will be required after games and this will be difficult to manage. The following risk assessment will aid the management of the risk

### HAZARDS

**Assisting the spread of COVID -19 for Players, Club officials and Volunteers.**

If controls are not considered then we may increase the risk of COVID-19 spreading from the site. Dressing room use will be difficult to manage but with some simple controls in place the risk can be lowered to a reasonable level

**Slips trips and falls**

There is some risk within this area but it is minimal.

### CONTROL MEASURES

**Monitoring and supervision**

The dressing rooms will be monitored to ensure that, as per the guidelines, no more than **6 persons** use the facilities at one time before and after the match. At half time 11 persons and the manager can access the dressing rooms as the duration of occupancy will be less than 15 minutes.

**Accessing the area**

Everyone to social distance when accessing the dressing rooms area.

**Signage to the consumer**

Maintain social distancing; Hand sanitising, wash your hands.

**Hand sanitiser available**

At toilet points within dressing room areas hand sanitiser will be available as will soap and hot water. Paper towels and waste receptacles are also be available.

□ **Enhanced cleaning checks**

The dressing room areas will be disinfected after each use and all touch surfaces like floors, door handles, locks, taps and benches will be sanitised. Stock checks of sanitizing items will be checked at this time.
